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Cazalet, AOP Faugères - Rouge 2018



Region: Languedoc

Appellation: Faugères

Terroir: Schist

Varieties: 50% Syrah, 50% Grenache

Content: 750 ml

Alcohol: 14 % vol

Ages up to 7 years

Wine making: *The grapes used for « Cazalet » are coming from various old vineyards in the villages of Cabrerolles, Autignac and Laurens. Through the mix of diverse terroirs, Lou Cazalet achieves an interesting consistency from one vintage to the next.*

Grapes are hand-picked, sorted in the cellar, 100 % destemmed and vatted for three weeks.

Maturing: Syrah in wooden tanks, Grenache in concrete tanks.

Tasting notes Cazalet 2018

Red fruits, spices and menthol notes from Grenache, concentration and roundness of Syrah, fine and structured tannins from Mourvèdre, fresh and aromatic herbs from Carignan: according to the purest, southern French tradition, each grape variety seems to bring its character and advantages into this cuvée. Showing full body and balance, as well as a fine tannin structure this wine is promised to a great future. Keep it for a couple of years in the cellar or serve it now on lamb cutlets with honey and thyme, grilled mussels or eggplant lasagna.
